Employer/Sole Trader Obligations

Once you have registered your trainee(s) on to the trainee scheme you are committing to provide practical training over the 18-month program. You are required to appoint a supervisor or manager to the trainee and commit to providing evidence of practical application of materials or surface preparation principals over this period. By registering your trainee(s) you are responsible in supporting the individuals training development to achieve their NVQ level 2 qualification for assessment.

All employers (including Sole Traders) must commit to supervision, mentoring and onsite training throughout the 18-month period, providing onsite experience which must be logged on the FeRFA portal to qualify for NVQ accreditation for assessment of skills by a Ferfa approved Assessor.

When employers/sole traders register new trainees on the NVQ level 2 training course you are agreeing to the Terms and Conditions of Ferfa training and fees.

How do you qualify to register as a trainee?

Have a full-time contract in accordance with current employment legislation.

Be a Sole Trader registered with the CITB as a levy payer

The new trainee must not have enrolled on any other CITB scheme.

Prior to registering your trainee, you must ensure that they have a registered CSCS card for Health & Safety compliance.

There is no age limit to register employees to sign up to qualify for the NVQ level 2 qualification.
